Children's Curriculum Interview Y1,2,3,4,6

- All of the children like computing.
- All of the children enjoyed Mega Coding Day.
- The following things were covered on the day:
 - ✓ Morse Code
 - ✓ Scratch Jnr
 - ✓ Investigating, tinkering.
 - ✓ Colour change, background, making characters move and talk.
 - ✓ How to fix errors in code.
 - ✓ How to make a maze.

- Some of the children had prior coding knowledge but all agreed that their coding skills had progressed e.g. learning how to move characters from side to side, jump and how to use it properly.
- Problems encountered included when the children forgot to go through certain stages in the procedure, but teachers helped them out, sometimes getting the steps the wrong way round or forgetting to save changes. The help sheets helped to trouble shoot issues so the children didn't always need to ask teachers.
- Some children need more help to save their work.
- The children all agreed that they were proud of their work that day because they worked well together and produced quality pieces.
- One child realised that she doesn't like coding so she isn't keen on Scratch.
- The day had inspired some children to work on Scratch at home.
