- * The Year 5 and Year 6 (Upper KS2) assembly will be at St. Marks Church starting at 2:15pm

All parents and carers are very welcome to join us in our celebrations both at school and church – we plan for each one to last 40 mins.

- Sugar, coffee, teabags.
- UHT milk
- Breakfast cereals

- Rice, no larger than 1Kg bags
- Pasta, no bigger than 500g bags
- These items need to be unopened and have a sell-by date of at least six months hence.
