Hands on History The Old School House Thursday 5th October 2017



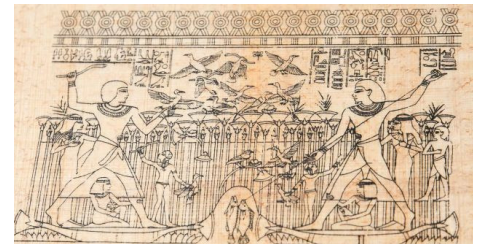

As part of our “Incredible Egyptians” topic, Year 4 will be going on an educational visit to the Egyptian Museum based in the Old School House in Hull City Centre.

They will be taking part in three workshops: “Every object tells a story”, “Mummification” and “Discover Egyptian Writing”. The workshops will enable the children to develop their knowledge of many aspects of ancient Egyptian society.

The children will be leaving school after registration time and will return in time to be collected at 3:30pm. As this educational visit is for a full day, your child will need to bring a packed lunch with them. This needs to be in a clearly labelled carrier bag and must not contain any glass or fizzy drinks.
