This Week

- **FS** – have made Incy Wincy Spiders and webs. Have explored pumpkins and looked at what is inside. We have also been learning to use scissors correctly and take turns when playing games.
- **Drewton** – enjoyed tasting a variety of food which comes from a farm. We also sorted animals into groups.
- **Sugarloaf** – classifying animals in Science. Food tasting in Topic. Sorting shapes in maths.
- **Sandholme** – moving and designing vehicles.
- **Barmby** – have written our own 'Where the Wild Things Are' story and have classified, built and evaluated a moving vehicle model.
- **Carlton** – Locating continents and oceans on a world map. Note making to write a report about St Lucia / UK.
- **Gowdall** – making notes on St Lucia and then writing a report to compare it to the UK. (While wishing we had a school trip to St Lucia.)
- **Drax** – in English we have been looking at all of the features of poetry. We then wrote descriptive paragraphs about Egypt using similes, metaphors and alliteration. In topic we rounded up our learning.
- **Smeaton** – writing Egyptian poems. Assessing and reviewing topic. Mindfulness – releasing our worries and identifying what fills our hearts.
- **Hensall** – making Greek pots using clay. Finding out how Greek scholars influenced modern day.
- **Upton** – making Greek pots. Tackling fractions in maths. Finding out how old we would be on Mercury.
- **Cudworth** – parenthesis work in Literacy. Working on our own plays to illustrate British values.
- **Hemsworth** – maths – problem solving. Science Day – light and shadows.
- **Whole school** – the children heard how Miss Morgan is going to be away for a few months in the near future as she has lovely news – she is expecting a baby in the spring. Film Night was another enjoyable event. Drewton had Golden Time and Two Parents' Evenings were well attended and it seems, appreciated.

Phew! What a 'we made it to the end of our first exciting, thrilling, exhilarating and completely exhausting half term,' kind of school.
