
Year 1 Information for Parents

Dear Parents/Carers

This half term the children will be taking part in a topic called 'Titanic'.

The children will start by recapping on the words 'past', 'present' and 'future' and relating this in time to the sinking of the Titanic. The children will be looking closely at the events leading up to the sinking of the Titanic and what happened during and after the sinking. They will have the opportunity to order the main events using writing, drama and role-play to support.



Throughout the topic, the children will be handling replica artefacts and photographs, using these to support their understanding. They will be introduced to the Morse code and discover how this is used to signal for help. The children will finish their topic by designing and drawing their own ship.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind you that we really do need your support to listen to your child read every day. Please record when they have read in their reading record book. Please ensure that you also support your child in working through their 'Train Platforms'.

Indoor and outdoor PE kits should remain in school all week as our PE days will change depending on the weather.

Acre Spells / Sentences will continue to be given out each Monday and can be returned when they have been completed.

Homework – This half term's homework is a research project. We would really appreciate it if you could spend some time with your child in researching the Titanic (but probably not the film!). There is a lot of information to be found in the library as well as on the internet. Your child could simply discuss their findings or he/she may wish to present them on a poster/booklet/PowerPoint.

You are welcome to send in a memory stick but please ensure it has had antivirus software run on it first. During the week beginning **5th February**, your child will have the opportunity to discuss or present his/her findings to the class.
