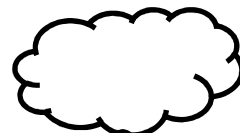

### This Week

**Foundation Stage** – enjoyed gymnastics in PE and practised jumping safely. We had three fabulous trips to 'Build a Bear' and the children are very excited about taking a turn to take the class bears

**Year 1** – Studying artefacts to find out what it would have been like aboard the Titanic. Investigating the properties of 3D shapes and making 3D shape models.

**Year 2** – learning about forces and friction by creating rockets with Spectaculab, writing applications to become astronauts and continuing working with money in maths.

**Year 3** – reading different poetry styles. Wrote a Bronze Age diary. Leaned how to make right angled turns. Painting like Jackson Pollock and Wassily Kandinsky in art.

**Year 5** – We had a visit from a professional who works at Hull Prison. Painting still life objects. Circuit training in PE and finding prime numbers in maths.

**Year 6** – lots of advanced punctuation, using complimentary colours in our artwork. Doing our fit for 5 exercises. Percentages of numbers in maths. Artwork in the style of Ben Mosley.

**Whole School** – really enjoyed watching the Drax class assembly and marvelled at how the children continued to sing when the music stopped. Lip sync battle champions! Lewis the Therapy Dog came to visit and showed us his sitting and staying techniques. Mrs R and Mrs Brady sorted parts for Jonah.
