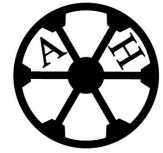




Acre Heads School Development plan 2017 – 2018

The Children

- To raise the percentage of High ability girls in KS2 achieving Expected level percentages in maths.
- To raise the percentage of High ability children in KS1 Greater Depth percentages.
- To raise the Y1 phonics percentage, especially for SEN children who are making it by Y2 but not Y1. (Y2 = 100%)
