This Week

Foundation Stage – continued learning about Chinese New Year. Tasting Chinese food and using chopsticks. We have made dragons in art and construction materials.

Year 1 – retelling the story of Little Red Riding Hood and acting it out. Experimenting to see which material would be most suitable for an umbrella. Ordering the events of the Christian and Jewish Creation Story.

Year 2 – investigated how some materials change shape and have found out about the changes Florence Nightingale made. In maths we have been using our 2s, 5s and 10 times tables to solve problems.

Year 3 – Maths – telling the time. Literacy – writing instructions to make a vegetarian wrap. Topic – learning about the Mayan Creation story and cooking our own Mexican vegetarian tortillas.

Year 4 – continuing our journey deep into the rainforest by writing a detailed description. Writing persuasive letter to the loggers to ask them not to cut down the Great Kapok Tree. Rainforest collages.

Year 5 – Optical illusions artwork. Burning materials to observe the production of a different material. Designing book tokens to hopefully win books for our school.

Year 6 – ration and proportion, co-ordinates, reflection and rotation in maths. Telling the time en Français. Using a thesaurus to upgrade words! Admiring Charlie's hamster Oreó.

Whole School – in Ms Perkins' words – shivering – but loving the snow! World Book Day was fantastic with enthusiastic book swaps, energetic book trails, Upton's excellent class assembly and exciting dressing up.

Phew! What a busy 'Let it snow, let it snow – the cold never bothered me anyway' kind of school.
