### This Week

**Foundation Stage** – we have made treasure maps and explored the Treasure Island. We have counted treasure and tried sharing treasure amongst the pirates.

**Year 1** – Place Value, ten more and ten less, solving word problems in maths. Describing superheroes – using capital letters and full stops in sentences. Starting 'Beautiful British Isles' topic.

**Year 2** – Creating posters to tell people how to stay healthy. Retelling the story of the Three Little Pigs.

**Year 3** – Asking questions we want to find out about our new robot topic. Dancing like a robot, inventing our own robot and creating an advert for it. Estimation in maths.

**Year 6** – measuring angles with a protractor, adding and subtracting fractions. Revising tenses and pronouns in English. Practising answering comprehension questions. Looking at frogspawn.

**Year 4** – Setting new class and personal targets. Started our Science topic of sound and electricity. In computing we have discovered how to insert and edit text and images using 'Word' and in history we have explored stories from the past and the history of pearl diving.
