(General Data Protection Regulation)

Changes to data protection law

You may be aware that from today, the rules around data protection are changing. The 'General Data Protection Regulation' (GDPR) will change how we can use your personal data and keep it safe, and will also strengthen your rights over your own data.

The point of this is to make sure sensitive or private information about yourselves and your children stays safe. Whilst it is similar to the current Data Protection Act in many ways, there are a few differences, so we need to make a few changes at the school in order to ensure we remain compliant.

One of these changes is that we have updated our privacy notice. You will soon find it on the website and we have already emailed it out to you earlier this week.

Please continue to use the app or drop in to the Welcome Desk to keep us updated of any change of personal details or contact information that you feel has relevance to us.
